CLASS PROCEDURES

START OF CLASS

- Come in quietly
- Get calculator and pencil

MAKE UP

Students are expected to complete make up work they missed while they were absent. When an absence occurs, it is the student's responsibility to inquire with the teacher, to check Schoology, and to complete and to submit all required assignments. Students are encouraged to utilize/to to Schoology for any notes, instructions, assignments, and examples. Students have one day for each day absent to complete and submit assignments. See timeline below.

Example Timeline:

1 day = 1 day to submit assignments

2 days = 2 days to submit assignments

***Any makeup work not submitted by timeline will follow the late work policy guidelines.**

NOTE: Tests can be made up during PE. The student will need to report to my classroom and should not report to PE on the day of the make up.

LATE WORK

Classwork is due the same day it is assigned. If a student is at school but does not complete their assignment, Most classwork is practice without penalty so students should take advantage of these "easy" grades.

WAGGLE

Students are required to complete 30 minutes of Waggle each week. This assignment cannot be made up and is worth 200 points for each 15 minute assignment. Students will have from Friday to Thursday to complete their 30 minutes.

RETEST

Students will have one retest per quarter. The retest must be taken with a one week of the original test.
